In the event a concern or allegation is raised in relation to child abuse that has occurred under the DFNC's care, the DFNC will ensure it is treated seriously, in a culturally sensitive manner and fully investigated in accordance with relevant legislation and the DFNC's Policy and Procedures.

The DFNC will actively promote the safety and wellbeing of children and young people, recognising the need for community football clubs to take direct responsibility for providing a safe physical and online environment for children and young people in their care.
